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Notes:

- 1. The figures of the quarters ended 31st March are the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and published year to date figures up to the third quarter of the relevant financial year.
- 2. The Board of Directors at its meeting held on 24th May, 2017, has recommended a Final dividend of Rs.18/- (180%) per Ordinary share of Rs.10.00 each [Previous Year Interim Dividend Rs.17/- (170%) per Ordinary Share]. In terms of revised Accounting Standard (AS) 4 'Contingencies and Events occurring after Balance Sheet date' as notified by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs through amendment to Companies (Accounting Standard) Amendment Rules, 2016, the Company has not appropriated proposed dividend (including tax) aggregating Rs.11936.05 lacs from the Surplus as per Statement of Profit and Loss for the year ended 31st March, 2017. The recommended dividend will be accounted for when approved by the shareholders.
- In relation to the Company's investment in Tata Teleservices Ltd., the value of which has progressively diminished (based on an independent valuation report), the Company concluded at 31st March, 2017, that such diminution is permanent in nature. Accordingly previous provisions for diminution in value, previously charged to the Securities Premium Account in accordance with the Orders of the Honorable Bombay High Court (Rs. 609.40 lacs upto 31st March, 2016 and Rs 445.11 lacs and Rs. 215.45 lacs during the quarters ended June 30, 2016 and December 31, 2016 respectively), were reversed and the cumulative write down of Rs.1269.96 lacs was debited to the Statement of Profit and Loss for the quarter and year ended 31st March, 2017.
 - The carrying value of such investments is Rs 666.21 lacs as at 31st March, 2017, based on an independent fair valuation carried out during the guarter ended 31st December, 2016.
- 4. There were no exceptional / extraordinary items during the above mentioned periods. Further, as the Company has no activities other than those of an investment company, Accounting Standard 17 'Segment Reporting' is not applicable.
- 5. As per the Orders of the Honorable Bombay High Court, the following provision / (write back) for diminution in value of investments have been adjusted to the Securities Premium Account instead of to the Statement of Profit and Loss, as per the Accounting Standard 13 'Accounting for Investments':

- 6. The financial information presented in the Statement, except Part II, is extracted from the audited standalone and consolidated financial statements as stated.
- 7. The Net Asset Value (NAV) of the Company's equity share, as computed by the management, and which is not subject to audit/review, is on the basis of the market value of quoted investments, NAVs of unquoted mutual funds, and in case of unlisted investments; on the most recently available independent valuations / financial statements.
- 8. The above results are prepared in accordance with the principles set out in Accounting Standard 21 'Consolidated Financial statements' and Accounting Standard 23 'Accounting for Investments in Associates' in Consolidated Financial Statements.
- 9. Previous periods' figures have been regrouped / recomputed, wherever necessary.
- 10. The above results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee in its meeting held on 24th May, 2017 and were approved by the Board of Directors in its meeting of date.

- 2. The consolidated financial results also include the Group's share of net loss of Rs. 131.64 lakhs for the year ended 31st March, 2017, as considered in the consolidated financial results, in respect of two associates, whose financial statements have not been audited by us. These financial statements have been audited by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our opinion on the consolidated financial results, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of a subsidiary and associates, is based solely on the reports of the other auditors.

Our opinion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matters with respect to our reliance on the work done and the reports of the other auditors.
