# NCDEX aims to relaunch groundnut futures trade

Rajasthan, Gujarat likely to be delivery points for trade

New Delhi, March 7

**COMMODITY BOURSE** THE National Commodity and Derivatives Exchange (NCDEX) will be relaunching futures contracts of groundnut in the next couple of weeks, trade sources said. NCDEX had discontinued trading in groundnut futures around 2010.

They said that groundnut prices witness volatility and global participation and interest in the commodity segments has increased in the last two years.

The futures trade in groundnut is likely to help farmers in hedging the risk in prices on the exchange platform, sources said.



The futures contract on the commodity exchange will be for 'groundnut with shell' and Rajasthan and Gujarat are likely to be the delivery points for trade.

Groundnut is grown largely in kharif season. Gujarat is the largest producer of groundnut in the country, followed by Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra and West Bengal. Meanwhile, with fall in

prices of mustard seeds due to bumper output, farmer producer organisations (FPO) have revived their demand for resumption of futures trade in groundnut.

In December 2021, SEBI banned futures trade on seven agricultural commodities including non-basmati paddy, wheat, chana and mustard seeds for one year citing rising prices. Earlier, mustard seed and chana (gram) futures trade were suspended on October 8,

2021 and August 16, 2021.

The ban on futures trade in several agricultural commodities had been further extended by a year.

The suspension of futures trade in several agricultural commodities on the commodity exchanges has no impact on the retail price volatility, according to a study conducted by academicians from top institutions including Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Udaipur.

Stating that suspension from futures market is often justified on the grounds of speculative activity emanating from trade in the futures market, the study titled 'Assessing the impact of commodity derivative suspension' stated that it has not found any role of futures market trading on price change, nor did it find any empirical evidence of impact of suspension of trade on price behaviour.

## Plan to build ethanol stock to meet E20 fuel demand

**THE GOVERNMENT** IS planning to create a carry over stock of ethanol for the next year anticipating a rise in demand for E20 fuel in the country, according to a senior food ministry official.

E20 fuel is a blend of 20% ethanol with petrol. The government aims to achieve the 20% ethanol blending target by 2025.

"Ethanol blending is going well. Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) have started dispensing E20 fuel in about 100 outlets in 31 cities in the country. We have started E20 fuel, if it goes well then the requirement will be more," Additional Secretary in the food ministry Subodh Kumar said.

Like sugar, the government "plans to create a carryover stock of ethanol" with OMCs and distilleries for 2023-24 ethanol year (December-November) and more sugar would be diverted for the same, he said.

The government has kept the 12% ethanol blending target in the ongoing 2022-23 ethanol year, while 15% for the next year. "About 120 crore litres has been blended with petrol till February-end. We are continuously blending 12%. The ethanol availability and production capacity is sufficient to meet this year's target," the official said.

For the current year, about 5 million tonnes of sugar is estimated to be diverted for ethanol production, higher than 3.6 million tonnes in 2021-22.

To meet 15% blending target next year, the official said additional 1,500 million litres of ethanol would be required and the government is encouraging sugar mills and distilleries to enhance production capacity.

# Govt plans to ease norms for cross-border flow of data

**IN A MOVE** that could further liberalise conditions for data transfer, the proposed new law could allow global data flows by default to all jurisdictions other than a specified negative list of countries where such transfers would be restricted, The Indian Express has learnt.

Moreover, a provision on "deemed consent" in the draft Digital Personal Data Personal Bill, 2022, could also be reworded to make it stricter for private entities while allowing government departments to assume consent while processing personal data on grounds of national security and public interest. The Bill could also incorporate a provision to ensure it does not come in conflict with pre-existing regulations issued by other Departments or Ministries.

These are among the key changes the government is considering to the proposed data protection Bill after feedback received from a range of stakeholders. The Bill is a key pillar of an overarching framework of technology regulations the Centre is building which also includes the Digital India Bill – the proposed successor to the Information Technology Act, 2000; Indian Telecommunication Bill, 2022; and a policy for non-personal data governance.

The current provision on cross-border data flows, as prescribed under Clause 17 of the draft data protection Bill, states that the Centre will notify countries or territories where personal data of Indian citizens can be transferred.

Sources said this is likely to

be amended with the Bill allowing cross-border data flows to all geographies with an official blacklist – of countries where transfers would be restricted.

This change is seen as a move to ensure business continuity for enterprises and to place India as a crucial part of the global data transfer network – an important element of trade negotiations the country is currently exploring with key regions such as the European Union.

"Instead of a white-list approach, the government is looking to follow an allowed-by-default model," a senior official said. "So, if the government does not want data to be transferred to a particular region, it will mention that region in its blacklist."

One concern, sources said, has been unchecked data transfers to China. In the last three years, the government had taken action against a number of platforms developed by China-based companies including ByteDance's TikTok and Tencent's PUBG. In the digital information sector, apps and websites believed to transfer data to China have been blocked and in other sectors, scrutiny has stepped up, especially over funds coming into India from Chinese entities.

For instance, in April 2020, the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), by way of press note 3 of 2020, announced a critical change to the Consolidated Foreign Direct Investment Policy (FDI Policy). This called for prior approval of the government for FDI by any entity based in any country sharing a border with India. Earlier, FDI

from entities based in Pakistan or Bangladesh were subject to government approval. This change was driven by an intent to stem any attempts by Chinese firms to take control of Indian firms which at the time were affected by Covid-related lockdowns.

Another key change that is expected in the final version of the Bill is to tighten the much-criticised provision of 'deemed consent' for how private entities can process personal data. "There were concerns over the misuse of this provision by private entities, so the government is considering changing the provision to exclude private entities," the official said. However, government entities are expected to be allowed to process assuming deemed consent, as has been prescribed in the draft Bill.

Under Clause 8 of the original draft, a user is said to have given consent to the processing of her personal data if the same is considered necessary. What the provision essentially means is that if a user has voluntarily shared her data with an entity for a certain purpose, that entity can assume her consent for other adjacent purposes and does not have to seek fresh consent for it. If other sectoral laws prescribe a higher standard of data protection on account of national security or other factors, then the data protection Bill will not supersede them, the official added.

"So, if there are sectoral regulations related to, for instance, health where such data is subject to a certain degree of privacy, that regulation will prevail over the data protection Bill," the official said.

## Palm oil imports may jump to 4-year high

**INDIA'S PALM OIL** imports could jump 16% in 2022-23 to a four-year high of 9.17 million tonne, as consumption is set to jump after two years of contraction due to Covid-led lockdowns, a senior industry official told Reuters on Tuesday.

Higher purchases by the world's biggest importer of vegetable oils could lead further support to palm oil futures, which are trading near their highest level in four months. "Consumption fell for two straight years because of the pandemic. This year, it would rebound by about 5% as restrictions have eased and prices have fallen," said Sudhakar Desai,

president of the Indian Vegetable Oil Producers' Association. The consumption growth would be fulfilled by higher imports of palm oil, which has been trading at a discount to rival soyoil and sunflower oil, he said. India's palm oil imports in the first four months of the 2022/23 marketing year that started on November 1 jumped 74% from a year ago to 3.67 million tonne, traders estimate.

India buys palm oil mainly from Indonesia, Malaysia and Thailand. It imports soybean and sunflower oil from Argentina, Brazil, Russia and Ukraine. The country's total vegetable oil imports could rise to 14.38 million tonne in the current year from 14.07 million tonne a year ago, Desai said. —REUTERS

## CBI questions Lalu in land-for-jobs scam for nearly 5 hours

**THE CBI** ON Tuesday questioned former railway minister and RJD supreme Lalu Prasad for nearly five hours in two sessions in the land-for-jobs scam case, officials said.

The case pertains to people allegedly given employment in the railways in return for land parcels gifted or sold at cheap rates to the Yadav family and its associates, they said.

A team of five CBI officials arrived in two cars around 10.40 am at the residence of Misa Bharti in Pandara Park near India Gate where Prasad is currently residing, and left around 12.55 pm for lunch. The questioning resumed around 2.15 pm which continued till 5.15 pm, they said.

During the exercise, which was being videographed, the former Bihar chief minister

was confronted with some documents in a room where he is quarantined post his kidney transplant surgery, the officials said.

Prasad underwent a kidney transplant in Singapore last year and returned to India a month ago. In view of the high risk of infections, the mass leader has chosen to stay away from his home state and convalesce at the residence of Bharti, who is a Rajya Sabha member.

His Singapore-based daughter Rohini Acharya took to Twitter to express her anguish over Prasad's interrogation by the CBI. "These people are harassing papa. If the harassment leads to any problem, we will rock the seat of power in Delhi. Patience is running out," she tweeted.

The CBI has filed a charge sheet in the case against

# Govt accepts report on smart power transmission system

**THE POWER MINISTRY** on Tuesday said that the government has accepted a report of a task force or expert panel, which paves the way for modern and smart electricity transmission system in India.

The country will soon have a modern and smart power transmission system with features such as real-time monitoring and automated operation of grid, better situational assessment, capability to have increased share of renewable capacity in the power-mix, enhanced utilisation of transmission capacity, greater resilience against cyber attacks as well as natural disasters, centralised and data-driven decision-making, reduction in forced outages through self-correcting systems etc., a power ministry statement said.

These and other recommendations are part of a report of a task force set up by the power ministry in September 2021 under the chairmanship of Power Grid chairman and man-

aging director to suggest ways for modernisation of transmission sector and making it smart

and future-ready, it stated.

The other members of the task force included representatives from state transmission utilities, Central Electricity Authority (CEA), central transmission utilities, MeITY (Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology), IIT Kanpur, NS-GPMU and EPTA.

During the meeting, the minister emphasised that a modern transmission grid is vital to achieve the government's vision to provide 24x7 reliable and affordable power to the people and also meet the sustainability goals. Singh said that a fully automated, digitally controlled, fast responsive grid which is resilient to cyber attacks and natural disasters is the need of the hour. The minister said that such a system should ensure isolation of specific areas in case of any contingency, so as to protect the grid and prevent larger outages. Appreciating the efforts of the task force, Singh directed the CEA to formulate necessary standards and regulations for adoption of identified technological solutions.

The task force in its report

has recommended a bouquet of technological and digital solutions, which can be adopted to make the state transmission grids future ready. These recommendations have been clubbed under categories of modernisation of existing transmission system; use of advanced technology in construction and supervision, operations and management; smart and future-ready transmission system; and up-skilling of workforce.

The task force has recommended centralised remote monitoring, operation of substations including SCADA, flexible AC transmission devices (FACTS), Dynamic Line Loading system (DLL), Wide Area Measurement System (WAMS) using PMUs and data analytics, Hybrid AC/HVDC system, predictive maintenance technique using AI/ML algorithms, HTLS conductors, process bus based protection automation and control GIS/Hybrid substation, cyber security, energy storage system, and drones & robots in construction/inspection of transmission assets.

## New thermal units get 40% green energy mandate

**THE MINISTRY** OF Power has mandated new coal or lignite-based thermal plants to either set up renewable energy capacity equivalent to at least 40% of the thermal plant's capacity or procure that much supply of green energy under renewable purchase obligation.

Earlier this month the power ministry amended the Tariff Policy 2016 under the Electricity Act, 2003, to impose the renewable purchase obligation of 40% for the new coal or lignite-based thermal power plants to be set up from April 1, 2023 onwards, showed a notification.

A coal/lignite based thermal generating station with COD of the project between April 1, 2023, and March 31, 2025, shall be required to comply with RGO of 40% by April 1, 2025.

Any other coal/lignite based thermal generating station with COD of the project after April 1, 2025 shall be required to comply with RGO of 40 per cent by the Commercial Operation Date.

Further, a captive coal/lignite-based thermal generating station shall be exempt from requirement of RGO subject to its fulfilling renewable purchase obligations as notified by the Centre, it stated. This assumes significance in view of India's ambitious target of having 500 MW of renewable energy capacity by 2030.

## Excise case: Court sends businessman to ED custody

**A DELHI COURT** on Tuesday sent Hyderabad-based businessman Arun Ramchandra Pillai to ED custody till March 13 and liquor baron Amandeep Dhall to judicial custody till March 21 in a money-laundering case related to the alleged Delhi excise policy scam.

Special Judge MK Nagpal sent Pillai to the Enforcement Directorate's custody after the

agency produced him before the court and said his custody was required to unearth the larger conspiracy and find the money trail. The agency also said Pillai was a close associate of Bharat Rashtra Samithi MLC K Kavitha and he was required to be confronted with other accused in the case.

Pillai was arrested on Monday night following his day-long

questioning by the ED.

The other accused, Dhall, the executive director of Brindco Sales Private Limited, was arrested on March 1 under provisions of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) following his questioning.

Brindco is a major importer and distributor of a variety of liquor brands and related beverages.
