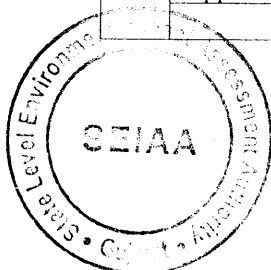


Minutes of the 915th Meeting held on 19th October 2022

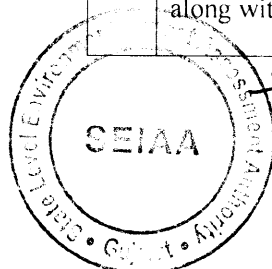

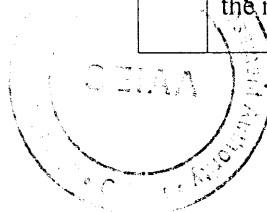



Note:

- These cases were deferred cases arising out of the recommendations of SEAC from which the proponents have not submitted the necessary critical information along with the original EC application for environment compliance. After the cases have been deferred, the revised submission of the proponents have been scrutinized and reconsidered by SEAC in its meeting dated 03.10.2022 and have recommended for grant of EC. SEAC is advised that such issues been very common, should impress upon the consultants so that the lapses were not repeated. SEAC should also ensure during the presentation by the proponents so that all essential information are presented by the proponents and are considered by SEAC in its minutes before recommending to SEIAA especially which have been raised during SEIAA's meetings of deferred cases or referred back cases.
- The EC orders should include and mention the compliances of the points particularly raised on the deferred cases such as final disposal of hazardous waste when it is sold to user under Rule 9, then mentioning about environmental monitoring, noise pollution and other measures and they should be factored in EMP budget outlay
- Where characteristics of chemicals in storage have been submitted in the revised presentation they should mention about safety measures taken including processes of chemical gas emission and related safety measures.
- Where scrubbing media/bleed liquor have been missing in the original EC application, they should be integrated in the order for compliance.
