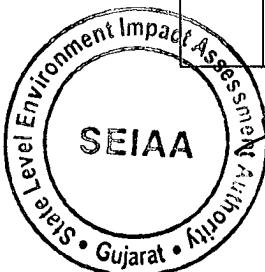


**Minutes of the 673<sup>rd</sup> Meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> December 2021 at 04.30 P.M.**

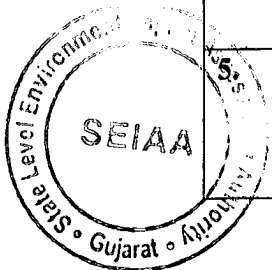

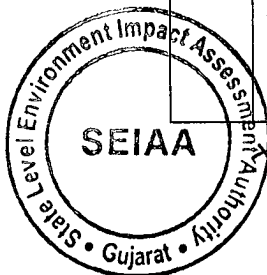

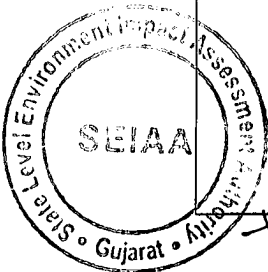
