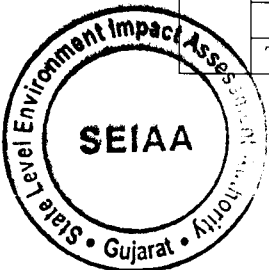


## Minutes of the 848<sup>th</sup> Pat-II Meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2022

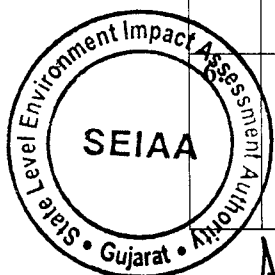



